# State agency seeks young artists to compete in calendar contest

Kansas students (kindergarten through grade 12) looking for a chance to showcase their artistic abilities have a chance to do so from now until March 18.

That's the deadline for the Kansas Department of Health and Environment's calendar contest, said Bill Bider, director of the Bureau of Waste Management.

The health and environment department is accepting student artwork to be considered for the 2006 "Kansas Don't Spoil It" calendar contest. The "Kansas Don't Spoil It" campaign promotes awareness about recycling, composting, littering, proper disposal of household hazardous waste (old paint, cleaning products, insecticides, and motor oil) and any other activity that helps keep the environment clean.

"We are looking for artwork that demonstrates the importance of good environmental practices and shows activities that everyone can participate in to preserve the beauty and natural resources of Kansas," Bider said.

Thirteen winning entries (one from each grade level K-12) will be

featured in the annual wall calendar that will be distributed throughout the state.

Artwork can be created using markers, watercolors, tempera, oils, crayon, chalk, acrylic, or colored pencils. Pen and ink artwork will not be accepted. All artwork must be submitted on 8.5" x 11", unlined, white paper. Artwork should be mailed flat; do not fold. Each entry must include the student's name, grade, school name, school address, school phone number, and teacher's name on the back.

Entries become the property of the state and may be used for promotional purposes. Entries cannot be returned.
