# Three earn All-Region

Three Colby Community College track/field Trojans earned All-Region honors at the Jayhawk West/Region VI meet this past weekend.

Sophomore Lionel Womack won the Jayhawk West championship in the javelin with a throw of 184 feet, one inch. The All-Region effort placed him third in Region VI and third in the Colby College record books. Womack will be traveling to Levelland, Texas on May 16 for the NJCAA national meet.

Freshman Kim Crossland also turned in an All-Region performance with a second place finish in the heptathlon. Her score of 3594 was good enough for second in the Jayhawk West and third in Region VI. It is the sixth best mark in school history.

Sophomore Jerod Kersey was the Trojan's third All-Region performer. His time of 35:41.91 in the 10000m placed him third in both the conference and the region. Kersey also posted a 10:15.31 in the 3000SC, good enough for sixth in both the conference and the region, and ninth in school history.

Other Trojans who performed well were freshmen Derrick Monson and Cassy Hamilton. Monson's time of 4:09.50 in the 1500m was fifth best in the region and put him fourth in the confer-

ence. Hamilton's distance of 40 feet marked her at both fourth in the region and conference.

The Trojan men finished eighth in the region with 25 points. The women finished 11th in Region VI with 15 points. Barton County won both the men's and women's sides.

The Trojans who have qualified for the national meet are Lionel Womack (javelin), Cassy Hamilton (shot put), Carlan Arthur (800m) and the 4x800m relay team of Felipe Longoria, Derrick Monson, Jerod Kersey and Arthur. A few of the athletes attended Thursday's last chance opportunity and those results are not known as of today.
