



Baseball Eagles now 16-2

Colby Eagle varsity baseball added two more wins to its record on Monday by taking two games from Healy-Leoti. Trenton Powell pitched the first game, giving up 4 runs on 6 hits. Senior Matt Augustine pitched the final inning and allowed 1 run on 1 hit.

Colby's offense got started early, putting 4 runs on the board in the first inning. Colby tacked on 3 runs the second, 2 in the fourth and 1 in the sixth. The final score was 10-5 Eagles.

Colby's offense was led by Jordan Cranston and Kyle Withington with two hits each. They were followed by Heath Bieker, Mitchell

Gatz and Brett Wilson with one hit each.

Jeremy Dietz took the mound in game #2. he gave up 1 run on 3 hits. the game ended after four innings by the run rule with the final score Colby 16, Healy-Leoti 1.

The offensive charge was led by Brett Wilson, going 3 for 3. Matt Augustine, going 2 for 3 and Joe Heier going 2 for 2. Everyone in the lineup found a way to get on base on hits, errors and drawing walks. Everyone in the lineup crossed the plate at least once.

The varsity's record is now 16-2. The last regular season game will be at Thomas More Prep at Hays on

Thursday at 4 p.m. Colby is ranked #1 in the region and hopes for a first-round home game on Monday, May 16.

According to coach Kevin Cox, the regional seedings will be out today. It looks as though Colby may get a home game against Goodland, Cox said that Colby's regional tournament may be as tough as any in the state. Teams included in the regional are Hugoton and Larned.

In preparing for regionals, the team will be stressing fundamentals of defense and offense.

Cox said his team is composed of "coachable kids who love the game."
