# Reviewing the programs

The Trojan baseball team had their season cut short last Saturday with a pair of losses in the first round of the playoffs to Kansas City, Kansas Community College. The Trojans (29-28) couldn't get any offense together in game one to make up for a few miscues and lost 12-1. Game two was a back-and-forth affair. The Trojans hit well and scored plenty of runs, but couldn't stop KCK (44-11) from scoring either, and lost 13-

Freshman Paul Roh went 5 for 6 with two doubles in game two and Brian Sulzman launched a two-run home run in the fourth inning that tied the game at three apiece. The Trojans were up 4-3 in the fifth, but KCK brought the score to a tie again and went ahead by two in the sixth. The Trojans answered with two in the top of the seventh to tie the score once more. KCK then took a five run advantage in the bottom of the seventh. The Trojans came right back in top of the eighth and cut the Devil lead to just two, but that was as close as they would come. There were no upsets in the region, as each higher seed won their playoff series. This weekend in Wichita the eight remaining teams will play a tournament for the right to go to the NJCAA World Series in Grand Junction, Colo. at the end of the month. The Trojans have a good group of players to build upon for next season. They return starters at several core positions. Look for great things from the Trojans next season.

## TRACK/FIELD

The Trojan track and field team took a small group of athletes to a last chance qualifying meet at Cowley County Community College last Thursday. Rocky Baalmann was the top Trojan performer. He set a school record in the 200m with a time of 21.96. Sophomore Jerod Kersey also had a good day, running a 10:11.08 in the 3000SC, which is the ninth best effort in Colby College history. Freshman Cassy Hamilton finished first at the meet in the shot put with a distance of 41 feet, 3 inches. 
