## Commodity distribution scheduled

United States Department of Agriculture commodities will be distributed on Wednesday, July 20 from 1:30-2:30 p.m. at the Retired and Senior Volunteer Program office in the Senior Progress Center, 165 Fike Park.

Eligible people may receive them according to income guidelines on the above date and time only.

No other arrangements for pickup will be made.

Distribution is on a first-come, first-served basis and may not begin until the advertised time. Participants are asked to not arrive at the distribution site before 1 p.m.

Eligible people who are not able to attend the distribution may send a signed permission slip with another person to pick up the commodities. Items include canned turkey, corn cereal, chocolate pudding, walnuts, dry milk, salmon, pineapple and strawberries.

For information, call the RSVP office at 462-6744. Also, the income guidelines have increased effective July 1. They are one person, \$1,037;

two, \$1,390; three, \$1,744; four, \$2,097; five, \$2,450; six, \$2,803; seven, \$3,156; eight, \$3,509; and for each additional family member, add \$354.
