## Oakley to host book signings

The Fick Fossil and History Museum in Oakley is hosting two book signings — one reaching back to ancient times with the other exploring the more recent past, said Janet Bean, museum director.

Mike Everhart, the author of *Oceans of Kansas, A Natural History of the Western Interior Sea*, will talk about his book and, fossils in general, beginning at 2 p.m., Saturday, Oct. 29, she said.

Tom Betz, author of *The Fleagle Gang, Betrayed by a Fingerprint*, will give a presentation on his book starting at 3 p.m., also that day.

“Although Kansas is now high and dry in the middle of the North American continent, at one time the state and most of the Midwest lay under water,” Everhart said about his book.

In fact, for those who have a fossil and have wondered about it, this will be their chance to have it identified, Bean said.

Betz, who is an editor and former publisher at the *Goodland Star News* in Goodland wrote about a true crime, she said.

“This is a fascinating book about a true crime and manhunt in Kansas,” she said, which takes place during the Roaring 20s.

The book is based on the murder of four men involved in a brazen daylight bank robbery in Colorado, Betz said.
