
Public Notice

UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY

In accordance with Section 311(b)(6)(C)(ii) of the Clean Water Act ("CWA"), 33 U.S.C. 1321(b)(6)(C)(ii), and 40 C.F.R. 22.45 of the Consolidated Rules of Practice Governing the Administrative Assessment of Civil Penalties, Issuance of Compliance or Corrective Action Orders, and the Revocation, Termination or Suspension of Permits ("Consolidated Rules"), the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") is providing notice of a proposed Administrative Penalty Assessment against Link Energy LLC ("Respondent"), an oil pipeline company with a business address of 2000 W. Sam Houston Parkway S, P.O. Box 4666, Houston, Texas 77210. The facility addresses that are a subject of this penalty assessment are known as the Oakley to Colby Line in Thomas County, Kansas, and the Colahan Lease in Ellis County, Kansas.

Under Section 311(b)(6) of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C. 1321(b)(6), the EPA is authorized to issue orders assessing civil penalties for various violations of the Clean Water Act. The EPA may issue such orders after filing a Complaint commencing a Class II penalty proceeding. The EPA provides notice of the proposed assessment of a Class II penalty pursuant to 33 U.S.C. 1321(b)(6)(C)(ii). Class II proceedings are conducted under EPA's Consolidated Rules, 40 C.F.R. Part 22. In this case, the EPA has filed a combined Complaint and Consent Agreement and Final Order, alleging that on or about November 10, 2002, Respondent's former facility caused a discharge of oil into or upon an unnamed tributary of the South Fork of the Saline River, and on or about May 16, 2003, caused a discharge of oil into or upon an unnamed tributary of the Saline River, in a quantity determined may be harmful to the public health or welfare of the United States, and therefore, violated Section 311 of the CWA, 33 U.S.C. 1321. The Consent Agreement and Final Order resolves these alleged violations for a proposed penalty of \$73,810.00.

The EPA will receive written comments on the proposed Administrative Penalty Assessment for a period of thirty (30) days from the date of publication of this notice. The procedures by which the public may submit written comments on a proposed Class II order or participate in a Class II proceeding, and the procedures by which a respondent may request a hearing, are set forth in the Consolidated Rules. Persons wishing to receive a copy of EPA's Consolidated Rules, review the Complaint and Consent Agreement and Final Order, comment upon the proposed penalty assessment, or otherwise participate in the proceeding should contact Kathy Robinson, Regional Hearing Clerk, U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Region VII, 901 N. Fifth Street, Kansas City, Kansas 66101. Please reference Docket No. CWA-07-2005-0369. In order to provide opportunity for public comment, EPA will issue no final order assessing a penalty in this proceeding prior to forty (40) days from the date of this notice.
