

Colby College cross country ready for regional championships

The Colby Community College cross country team traveled to El Dorado for the Ollie Isom Invitational last weekend. The men finished fourth behind Butler, Fort Hays and Garden. The women placed sixth. The story of the day however, was Denzel Ramirez's second place finish in the 5K race. Denzel put himself in the record books yet again with the second best time in Colby history. Carlan Arthur finished sixteenth despite a sore knee. Christa Perue headed up the ladies with a 26th place run.

This was the final tune up before the Region VI Championships on Monday, Oct. 24. The meet went well considering the weather was significantly warmer than what they had practiced in during the week.

Repairs on the way for Superdome

Superdome officials say the stadium should be largely cleaned up from Hurricane Katrina and ready for the New Orleans Saints to play at least some of their games there in 2006.

The announcement came as San Antonio officials said they were working with Saints owner Tom Benson to keep the team in Texas.

The Superdome, severely damaged by high winds, should have a temporary roof in place within 10 days, said Doug Thornton, regional vice president for SMG, which manages the stadium.

An environmental assessment of its interior — damaged by rainfall through holes in the roof and its use as a shelter for evacuees — should be finished by Dec. 1, he said.
