KU shuts down one of Web sites

LAWRENCE (AP) — The University of Kansas has shut down a Web site because it lacked property security to keep visitors from viewing financial and personal information about housing applicants, officials said Tuesday.

It's at least the third time in as many years the university has faced a computer-related security issue.

The university is trying to determine how to contact about 9,200 people who used the site to submit housing applications between April 29, 2001, and Dec. 16 of this year, the date officials said a regular review showed the site wasn't secure.
