Program to promote saving

MANHATTAN — You know the story — someone who spends a lifetime working in a low-paying profession leaves hundreds of thousands of dollars to improve the local library.

How did he or she do it?

“We may never know the specifics, but there is a lesson to be learned: No matter what the income, saving money need not be only a dream,” said Carol Young, Kansas State University Research and Extension family financial management specialist.

Typically even those who say they can’t save, usually can, she said.

“Age is irrelevant - it’s never too late to start saving, managing debt and building a secure financial future,” said Young, who is working with many Extension agents in the state to introduce Kansas Saves. The financial management campaign, which encourages saving and managing debt successfully, is part of a larger national effort called America Saves and sponsored by the Consumer Federation of America.

“The new Extension effort is a social marketing campaign, much like those that encourage wearing a
