Eagle wrestlers place third at Tournament of Champions

Colby wrestling coach Mitch Beims called it “one of the toughest tournaments we’ve ever been to.”

At the Newton Tournament of Champions last weekend Colby came in third place.

“We had a few surprises and a few disappointments, but overall we had a fine tournament,” Beims said.

The competition in all weight classes was fierce, but 140 was extremely competitive. Senior Cole Garcia’s bracket had three state champions and eight state placers in it, but he was able to get through his three matches unscathed for Colby’s only first place finish.

Garcia defeated Hentzen from Maize 9-2 in the finals, who was the 5A state champ last year.

“At 119, junior Trenton Powell’s only two losses were to last year’s 5A state champ and to the first place finisher who beat a three time state champion in the finals,” said Beims.

Also getting praise from the coach was junior Jared Flanagan.

“Jared wrestled some unbelievable matches, went 6-2 on the weekend, and picked up four pins,” Beims said.

The Eagles wrestle in a dual Thursday at Atwood. Colby competes Friday and Saturday at the Beloit Tournament.

Hoxie golfer ready to go pro

One of Hoxie’s own is stepping onto the green and turning professional in the field of golf.

Cole Nondorf, 23, is pursuing his dream of being a professional golfer and has formed Nondorf Golf Enterprises, LLP so others can participate.

“It’s always been my lifelong dream and I think I’ve got the game down and want to play with those guys and have it as my job,” Nondorf said.

Having developed a three-year plan, Nondorf will tell potential investors how they can partner with him through his limited liability partnership. Later this month, Nondorf will have an informative meeting. Time and date of the meeting are not yet scheduled.

“I think Cole’s got a great opportunity,” said Ken Eland, one of Nondorf’s supporters. “He’s had an outstanding college career and he’s got a great opportunity to become a professional.”

In order for Nondorf to pursue his golf career he’ll need financial sup-

port.

“Each dollar contributed will constitute one share, and there will be a minimum of \$1,000 contribution in the original investment,” Eland said.

“Cole’s projected budget is \$75,000 per year for three years, but if there’s sufficient winnings in year one or two, then the investor would not have to contribute a full \$1,000 in years two and three.”

Having played golf since grade school, Nondorf graduated from Hoxie High School in 2001 and completed a golf career at Fort Hays State University in 2005. Last year, Nondorf qualified for the United States Amateur by finishing in a tie for second place at the U.S. Amateur Sectional Qualified at Saddle Rock Gold Course in Aurora, Colo.

He then played in the 105th

Unites States Amateur Golf Championship tournament in August in Ardmore, Pa. Despite not such a good showing, shooting 84, 74 and missing the cut, Nondorf said “just making it there was an accomplishment.”

Nondorf will participate in several mini-tours in order to gain the experience necessary to obtain his PGA Tour playing card.

“My first tour, the Gateway Tour, starts in mid-March at Orlando, Fla.,” Nondorf said. “I’ll play a series of tours in the Orlando area and I’ll be moving to Orlando the first week of February.”
