slowly increasing over the past few years in Kansas, the state still ranks poorly against other states in seat belt use.

The national seat belt use rate is 82 percent. Drivers of pick up trucks were less likely than other odds of survival in light trucks by Kansans to wear seat belts. Last as much as 80 percent in the event year, the compliance rate was only 52 percent.

Of the 428 individuals killed in traffic crashes in the state last year, 70 percent were unrestrained. An even higher percentage of pickup truck drivers and passengers who were killed in traffic crashes were unrestrained, often because they were ejected from pick up trucks involved in roll-over crashes.
