A reputed Cherokee lawyer recognizes Turtle on a television show and shows up at Taylor's doorstep demanding that Turtle be returned to the Cherokee Nation. According to the Indian Child Welfare Act of 1978, no one can adopt a Cherokee child without tribal permission. Taylor's reaction is to run away until she realizes that running does not solve the problem.

The philosophical question handled thoughtfully by Barbara Kingsolver for the rest of this book, is whether Turtle should remain where her former abuses occurred — but where her identity is intact or alienation.

An interesting question and one which Kingsolver diplomatically frames with an insightful perspective into each.


