# Bulldog girls win

Golden Plains Bulldogs scored early and often in a 73-28 drubbing of the Natoma Tigers Tuesday at Natoma.

Golden Plains senior Katelyn Spreser led quartet of double figure scorers with 18 points. Kendra Spreser added 14 while freshman Aisha Walter scored a career high 12. Amanda Rall chipped in with 11.

Golden Plains shot 34-69 for 49 percent while holding Natoma to just 23 percent (12-53). Golden Plains outrebounded the Tigers 37-23 with Angel Lobato and Katelyn Spreser each having seven rebounds. Golden Plains (11-1) plays Logan Trojans Saturday in Rexford. Games start at 2 p.m.

# Kansas has its way with Baylor

WACO, Texas (AP) — Kansas' big early lead had quieted the Baylor crowd to the point that Brandon Rush could hear a handful of Bears fans heckling him.

His answer: a smile, a nod at the scoreboard, then a dunk.

"I heard it," Rush said. "It was real quiet. They didn't have any crowd to feed off of."

Officially, the attendance was listed at 8,102. But the crowd was peppered with vocal Jayhawks fans and Baylor fans had little to cheer about as No. 8 Kansas bolted to an early 17-point lead before settling into an easy 82-56 victory Wednesday night.

Rush scored 18 points and Julian Wright chipped in 16 as the Jayhawks held the Bears to 30 percent shooting and just a single basket for the first 11 minutes.

"We executed. We were aggressive. We looked a lot like the team

we're supposed to look like," Kansas coach Bill Self said.

The Bears' bench was quiet too. Coach Scott Drew was courtside a little more than 24 hours after having an appendectomy Tuesday, but he stayed in his seat and let assistant Matt Driscoll do most of the game coaching.

"Coach Drew was very involved in what was going on," Driscoll said. "I was just a puppet out there to get into the officials a little bit and get up and down a little bit."

Curtis Jerrells scored 12 to lead the Bears (11-8, 1-5).

Baylor, which has lost three straight and was coming off a 40-point defeat at Oklahoma, got off to a horrible start on its home court with 1-of-16 shooting and trailed by 22 at halftime.

Wright slammed two thunderous dunks early and the Baylor misfires frustrated Bears fans. It was still

early when the group sitting near the court tried to heckle Rush.

Instead of getting in Rush's head, the hecklers almost immediately went silent.

Sherron Collins hit a 3-pointer and Rush slammed down a rebound, then ran up court with another nod to the crowd, this time to a boisterous group of Kansas fans chanting "Let's go, Jay-hawks!"

"The game's not over by any means, but that can be a little frustrating to a crowd I would think," Self said. "I think it does take the air out of their sails."

Rush then hit a 3-pointer and a high, arcing shot at the buzzer to send the Jayhawks into halftime leading 40-18. Kansas shot 64 percent in the first half. He and Wright both had nine points and combined for 11 rebounds in the first half.

Wright's play early was critical to getting the big lead, Self said.

# West wins high scoring all-star game

DALLAS (AP) — Sidney Crosby and Alex Ovechkin are already thinking about their next All-Star game together. There should be plenty more chances for the young sensations — and likely soon.

Maybe next time, they won't be overshadowed on the ice.

While Crosby and Ovechkin were the main attractions in the league's first midseason showcase since 2004, the night belonged to one of the NHL's old stars.

Colorado's Joe Sakic, making his 12th All-Star appearance, had four assists to lead the Western Conference to 12-9 victory Wednesday night.

"It was a wide-open game with a lot of goals," said Sakic, who captained the West squad. "I don't know what more you want."

Maybe some more from the flashy young duo that's already being compared to Wayne Gretzky and Mario Lemieux.

Crosby and Ovechkin started on the same line and played most of the game together for the Eastern Conference, but just never could get into the flow. Ovechkin's goal in the second period was the only point be-

tween them.

"There were 21 goals, you think I would have had one," Crosby said, jokingly. "I guess it wasn't meant to be. I had a few chances, it just didn't work out."

The 19-year-old Crosby of the Pittsburgh Penguins, who was the top vote-getter for the All-Star game, leads the NHL in scoring with 72 points. Ovechkin, the 21-year-old Moscow native, was Rookie of the Year last season and has 65 points this season for Washington. His 29 goals are one shy of the league lead.

Gretzky, the only other teenager to lead the league in scoring, was also 19 when he made his first All-Star appearance in 1980 — and was also held without a point.

"That makes me feel a little better," Crosby said.

Gretzky went on to become the NHL's career scoring leader.

On several shifts, Ovechkin gave up the puck to Crosby, who still managed only three shots. Ovechkin took five shots, and whiffed on a couple of other chances.

"I tried to help him. Next All-Star

game, it will happen," Ovechkin said. "There were a couple of times I normally would have shot. But I wanted to play for the fans. I tried to help him but it didn't work."

Well-traveled Yanic Perreault of Phoenix, Columbus' Rick Nash, Minnesota's Brian Rolston and Martin Havlat of Chicago each had two goals for the West.

Daniel Briere, one of three starters from Eastern Conference-leading Buffalo, started the game on the line with Crosby and Ovechkin. While the youngsters struggled, Briere had a goal and four assists and was selected the MVP — playing the rest of the game with a different duo.

"With Sidney and Alex being the future faces of the NHL, I was kind of the other guy with the two," Briere said. "I had fun. I played one shift early on with them to start the game. But I don't think it really matters who you play with here. There's so many talented players."

Boston defenseman Zdeno Chara, at 6-foot-9 the tallest player in NHL history, scored two goals for the East squad.
