

Trojan track team member sets new weight throw record

The Colby Community College 3 indoor track team competed at the University of Nebraska-Kearney All-Comers meet Friday.

Ivan Guel established a new school record for the Trojans in the weight throw with a distance of 14.06 meters.

Other top finishers include Sherry-Ann Baggoo in the 400 (4th, 1:04.65), Lauren Kaiser in the 400 (5th, 1:04.81), Shawn Hunter in the 200 (4th, 23.78) and the 400 (4th, 52.68), Sandino Nero in the mile (4th, 4:47) and Onesmus Too in the 800 (3rd, 2:01.71).


