AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE SPEED LIMIT ON A CERTAIN STREET WITHIN THE CITY OF COLBY, THOMAS COUNTY, KANSAS, AS AUTHORIZED BY K.S.A. 8-1560.

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Colby, Kansas, determines that as a result of a traffic investigation conducted by City staff, a reasonable and safe maximum speed limit be declared on a certain street.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLBY, KANSAS:


SECTION 1. That the maximum speed limit on Willow, from Range Avenue (K-25) to Franklin Avenue, shall be 35 miles per hour; and

SECTION 2. That the speed limit established as hereinabove authorized shall be effective at all times when appropriate signs giving notice are erected upon such street.


SECTION 3. That any person convicted of a violation of any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished in accordance with the provisions of "The Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities", adopted by reference by the City of Colby.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication in the official City newspaper.

NOTICE OF SPECIAL QUESTION ELECTION
COLBY COMMUNITY COLLEGE, COLBY, KANSAS

The Governing Body of Colby Community College, Colby, Kansas (the "College"), has heretofore, pursuant to a Resolution duly adopted, declared it advisable to acquire, construct, install and equip (a) a Wellness/Activities Complex of approximately 115,000 square feet, which will include a 2,400-seat competition gymnasium, a secondary practice gymnasium with spectator seating, wrestling room, eight locker rooms, an elevated walking track, free weights, machine weights, cardio center, coaches' offices, all-purpose classroom, large concession area and a vestibule, (b) a 260-bed dormitory and (c) all other necessary improvements appurtenant thereto (the "Project") at an estimated cost of \$20,000,000. Notice is hereby given to the qualified electors of the College District (the "District") that a Special Question Election has been called and will be held on April 3, 2007, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of the District the following proposition:

Shall the following be adopted?

That the Governing Body of the Colby Community College shall be authorized to acquire, construct, install and equip (a) a Wellness/Activities Complex of approximately 115,000 square feet, which will include a 2,400-seat competition gymnasium, a secondary practice gymnasium with spectator seating, wrestling room, eight locker rooms, an elevated walking track, free weights, machine weights, cardio center, coaches' offices, all-purpose classroom, large concession area and a vestibule, (b) a 260-bed dormitory and (c) all other necessary improvements appurtenant thereto, at an estimated cost not to exceed \$20,000,000, by entering into a lease purchase agreement and, if advantageous, issue certificates of participation, with the principal amount of such lease purchase agreement to not exceed \$10,510,000 and the expected total of all payments, including interest, under said lease purchase agreement to be approximately \$15,950,000 (excluding amounts required for maintenance, taxes or insurance on the improvements)? The balance of the project costs shall be paid from grants and contributions the College expects to receive in an amount of \$5,000,000 and the proceeds of general obligation bonds of the College.

The following additional information is provided by the District with respect to compliance with the provisions of K.S.A. 10-120a and K.S.A. 12-6,122. No assurances can be given that these projections will be accurate as of the date of execution and delivery of the lease-purchase agreement due to changing market conditions, any changes in assessed valuation of the District, changes in the amount of state financial aid received by the District and other matters unknown or unavailable at this time. The projected rates of property taxation to be used to pay the principal of and interest on the Lease are based upon the current assessed valuation of the District, increased annually at an assumed three percent rate of growth, the assumed principal repayment schedule and the average interest rates from recent lease-purchase agreements for similar types of financings, all as shown below.
