Colby Community College head wrestling coach Steve Lampe signed two wrestlers for the 2007-08 wrestling season; T.J. Hepburn from Connecticut and Delanno Palmore from Georgia.

Hepburn, who wrestled at 140 pounds his senior season, will join the Trojans with an impressive high school resume. Hepburn recently finished third at the National High School Coaches Association senior national tournament.

According to www.homestead.com/CTwrestling, Hepburn has a Connecticut high school record of 194-3, including a 49-0 mark his senior

season. Palmore, who wrestled at 171 pounds his senior season, was the state champion in 2A for his high school. Palmore also wrestled at the NHSCA senior national tournament, but didn't place.

Lampe said he is very pleased with the signings, and both athletes will contribute to success of the Trojans next season. The coaching staff is still on the recruiting trail and looks to sign a few more wrestlers.

The Trojans lost only one sophomore (Levi Younkin) from a team that qualified eight members for nationals.

The standout performance was by the women's 4 x 400-relay team, which set a school record and qualified for the national meet. The team of Amanda Daugherty, Lauren Kaiser, Vicmari Prospero and Sherry-Ann Baggoo smashed the old record of 4:05.14, by running a time of 4:02.98.

Head coach Jeff Becker said the old record dated back to 1979 and now gives them both the indoor and outdoor school record.
