NOTICE TO THOMAS COUNTY RESIDENTS FARMING IN VIOLATION OF K.S.A. 68-545 REGARDING THOMAS COUNTY ROADS

The Thomas County Board of Commissioners, Road and Bridge Department, and Township Trustees are concerned about the unnecessary cost increase of roadway and right-of-way maintenance being caused by farming activities within the county and township right-of-ways. Any farming activity within the right-of-way erodes the county and township road systems. It is possible to restore significant amounts of gravel to the roads from the shoulders and therefore, farming the side slopes of the road buries that gravel, thus making it impossible to recover. Any spraying of ditches to destroy weeds and grasses will also be considered a violation of this law.

Kansas State Statute 68-545 states that a person violating the provisions of this statute shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be fined up to \$200 for each and every violation. In addition, all costs for clean up and restoration of the road may be recovered from the farmer whose practice is in violation of the statute by the county.

Repair of roadways damaged by such farming practices requires more gravel purchased and hauled and therefore other projects abandoned. The county and township road systems belong to you, the Citizens of Thomas County, and exist to serve you and your needs. We all must work together to protect this substantial investment. By this notice, the Thomas County Commissioners are requesting the assistance of farmers and county and township residents by becoming aware of the negative impact of such farming practices and assist the county road departments and townships in maintaining the integrity of your county and township road system.

The majority of Thomas County secondary roads are maintained on a minimum of sixty (60) feet right-of-way, that being from the center of the road a distance of thirty (30) feet each direction. Should a farmer have a question concerning a right-of-way width adjacent to his property, he should contact the office of the Thomas County Highway Department to determine the proper width of the right-of-way affecting his farming practices.

The county will begin legal action against those individuals who continue to farm public right-of-way with the offender being assessed the costs and fine set forth herein above.
