Each team's top four players provide the team score. The fifth best score breaks the tie. Colby's Kyle Molstad was the fifth Colby player. He shot a 96. Pratt's fifth player shot a 92. Colby missed out qualifying the entire team for state. Haas finished seventh among all golfers with a 78. That qualified him as an individual. Other Colby scores were from R.J. Ladenburger, 82; Cole Finley, 87 and Dylan Stithem, 93. Ladenburger missed qualifying by one stroke. Colby finished with a 340.


