

MOTHS can still damage clothing when it is stored? Our friends at the International Fabricare Institute suggest the following to keep moths from damaging your clothing:

• Have garments professionally cleaned and treated with mothproofing solutions before storage. • If home-washing, tumble dry at temperatures above 120 degrees F (if OK for the fabric – Heloise) to kill larvae.

• Freeze garments in individual self-sealing storage bags at 0 degrees F for 48 to 72 hours before storing to kill larvae. (I love this one! — Heloise)

• Use cedar, eucalyptus or lavender products to keep moths away.
