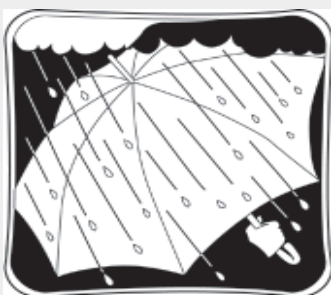


Weather Corner

Accident sends three to hospital

Three Garden City residents were taken to Sheridan County hospital in Hoxie after a semi-truck collided with the vehicle they were riding Friday afternoon.
According to a Kansas Highway Patrol report, Birgilio Adrian Bergerano, 23 of Garden City was southbound on Kansas Highway 23 about nine miles south of Hoxie when he attempted to turn left on to County Road 9 about 12:45 p.m.
Manuel E. Espino-Lira, 27 of Garden City, who was behind Bergerano driving a 1998 Freightliner semi was not able to stop for Bergerano's turn and struck the driver's side of Bergerano's 1993 Ford.
While Espino-Lira was not injured, Bergerano, along with Loripa Zamora, 29, and Tiffany Knight, 17, both of Garden City, were taken to Sheridan County Hospital by the Sheridan County Emergency Medical Service. According to Annie Staats, director of nursing at the hospital, all three individuals were treated and released.
Two children, Crystal Chavez-Zamora, 2, and Tranquility Chaavez-Zamora, 3, both of Garden City were passengers in Bergerano's car but were not injured. Occupants of both vehicles were wearing seat belts at the time of the accident.
