Vaughn Merritt "Pud" Humes

Vaughn Merritt "Pud" Humes, 89, of Russell, died Wednesday, June 27, 2007, at the Russell Regional Hospital in Russell.

Mr. Vaughn was born March 18, 1918, in Bunker Hill to Earl and Mecia (Mowry) Humes. He graduated from Bunker Hill High School and later attended the University of Kansas and Kansas Wesleyan University.

He enlisted in the U.S. Army April 1, 1942, serving with the 13th Engineer Battalion attached to the 17th Infantry in the Aleutian Islands, Southern Philippines Liberation, Luzon and Ryukyus. He was also part of the invasion of Marshall Island. He was awarded the Bronze Star, Oak Leaf Cluster and Purple Heart.

He was discharged Feb. 6, 1946. He married Donna Mae Moore Nov. 19, 1942 in Russell.

He and his father ran a grocery and hardware store in Bunker Hill. Later, he and his brother Donald operated a farming and livestock operation.

He served as mayor on the city council, was a member of the Center Township trustees and school board.

He served three terms on the

Russell county commission. He was also a member of the Russell VFW Post #624 and a past commander of the Dorrance American Legion.

He went to work for Nickerson Farms in 1970, managing some of their stores and was a district supervisor for a five-state area until his retirement in 1983.

Mr. Humes is survived by three daughters, Peggy Chrisler of Russell, Shelley Barton of Colby and Shayne Barnes of Russell; 12 grandchildren and 27 great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Donna Feb. 21, 1997; parents; brother Donald and one sister, Imogene Prester.

Services are at 2 p.m. Saturday at Russell Funeral Home with Pastor Earl Haggard officiating. Interment will be in the Bunker Hill Cemetery in Bunker Hill, with military honors by the Fort Riley Honor Guard. Visitation is until 9 p.m. today at the funeral home.
