

# Brewster golfer fights the wind to finish third

With winds gusting over 40 miles per hour, the Brewster Bulldog varsity boys golf team played their first tournament of the year Tuesday at the Scott Community Golf Course in Scott City.

Seniors Jance McKee and Michael Collett were the only two Bulldogs who competed in the 18-hole tournament. McKee shot an 84 and finished third. Collett placed 15th with a 95.

The winning score was an 80 from an Ulysses player, though his name was not reported. Landon Stevens of Wheatland/Grinnell finished second. Brett Gfeller of Triplains finished ninth after firing a 92. Boone Moser of Triplains

also competed at the event.

Ulysses won the overall team title with a score of 345. Wheatland-Grinnell was second at 351, and Scott City was third with a 378.

Other schools that competed in the tournament were Garden City, Dighton and Oakley.

Brewster's junior varsity golf team was also in action Tuesday at the Goodland JV Golf Tournament hosted at Sugar Hills Golf Course.

The nine-hole tournament consisted of 63 players from nine schools.

Attending from Brewster were sophomore Erik Roeder, freshman

Tate Preston, senior Baylee Westover and junior Melissa Crumrine.

In his first ever tournament, Roeder tied for 10th place with a score of 52. Also playing his first tournament was Tate Preston, who tied for 21st after firing a 57.

Colby's Chris Crocker battled the gusty wind conditions to shoot a first place score of 47.

Brewster's next varsity golf tournament is 9 a.m. Saturday in Oberlin.

The tournament was rescheduled from April 12. The Bulldog junior varsity will play 3 p.m. Tuesday at Scott City for their third tournament of the year.

# 3-run double helps Angels beat Royals

ANAHEIM, Calif. (AP) — Garrett Anderson doubled in three runs, Erick Aybar had an RBI double and scored another run on a grounder with the infield in, and the Los Angeles Angels beat the Kansas City Royals 5-3 on Thursday night.

Jon Garland (2-2) allowed two runs and seven hits over 6 1-3 innings with three walks and a strikeout. The right-hander, who has beaten Kansas City more often than any other club, is 17-6 against the Royals and 11-1 at home. This was the first time the nine-year veteran faced them in

anything but a Chicago White Sox uniform.

Francisco Rodriguez followed Justin Speier and Scot Shields out of the bullpen, pitching another nervous ninth for his sixth save. K-Rod gave up three hits, including a one-out RBI single by Alberto Calaspo. It was the only run he has given up to the Royals in 20 1-3 career innings against them.

The defending AL West champions played without All-Star right fielder Vladimir Guerrero, who bruised his right index finger while batting in the seventh inning of Wednesday's 3-2 loss.

Brett Tomko (1-2) gave up five runs and six hits over seven innings in his first start at Angel Stadium since April 2001, with Seattle. The right-hander, pitching for his seventh big league team, had allowed only two runs over 11 innings in his other two starts for the Royals.

Tomko was staked to a 1-0 lead on David DeJesus' RBI single in the third inning before giving up Anderson's three-run double off the wall in right-center in the bottom half. Anderson's first career hit off Tomko followed a two-out walk to Gary Matthews Jr.
