Tips on getting crayon stains out of pockets

Dear Heloise: Help! I washed and dried clothes with some crayons in a pocket. I need to know how to get the crayon out of my family's clothes. Any advice would be greatly appreciated and very helpful to me right now. --Amy H., via e-mail

Oops! This happens more than you know! You need to wash everything again with hot water, laundry detergent and 1-2 cups of baking soda.

If the spots are still there, wash bleach-safe clothes with chlorine bleach or oxygen bleach, using the correct amount on the package, in the hottest water that's safe for the fabric. Air-dry -- do not put them into the dryer.

If the stain is small, put paper toweling down and then the stain facedown.

Dab the area from the back side with cleaning fluid or remover until the crayon color stops bleeding through to the toweling.

Launder in the hottest water safe for the fabric, using plenty of detergent.




