Much of the on-campus decline has resulted from a phenomenon that became obvious in the past couple of years, the university says: Some students who live in Hays and nearby towns have begun to opt for the convenience of the Virtual College instead of driving to campus.


Nonetheless, he said, the university is working to reverse the decline in on-campus enrollment.
