Examples of recyclable electronic waste that the center will accept includes desktop and laptop computers, computer parts, cell phones, microwaves, answering machines, video disk and tape players, speakers, satellite receivers, toner and inkjet cartridges, and fax and copy machines.

The recycled items will be sent to Unicor a government corporation that gives jobs to inmates in federal prisons. The group will either recycle or refurbish the old

electronics, Koon said The center wants recyclers to

not leave anything outside. Computers and phones contain sensitive data, and a thief could get information about a person's identity from them, Koon said.

Groups with lots of recyclables should call (785) 460-1840 to make arrangements instead of bringing in the items during regular hours.
