# Hire employees likely to succeed

They don't say "Thank you!" to customers, help you find what you need or answer your question about merchandise or service. What has happened to standards in good customer service?

Have you ever seen an employee chat on the phone the entire time you're in a store? How about that "you're-bothering-me" attitude when you'd like to pay for your item?

I'm tired of it. I'm not patronizing establishments whose managers don't take the time to select, train, equip and demand excellence in customer service from their employees. As a consumer, I know I have choices, but the problem is annoying and it's not going away. By my standards, it's getting worse.

What's a business owner to do? I hear complaints about not being able to find good employees, about the revolving door, about pathetic attitudes, about employees just not showing up. It's got to stop if a business is to experience any level of success.

After all, you only have so many customers to alienate by ignorant, arrogant, oblivious front-line staff who are clueless. We all know it's a lot easier to maintain and build your business with satisfied existing customers than it is to "buy" a new customer through marketing and media.

So how do we fix this? First and foremost, hire the right person. Find someone who has your busi-

nesses' values, an understanding of and adaptability to the culture of your workplace. Identify key behavioral characteristics like, "likes to smile," "is friendly and outgoing," "has a positive attitude" and "enjoys helping people" and start writing a better job description to define the work of the position and your expectations.

Recruit from a pool of candidates who are most likely to succeed. Where have your best employees come from? Can they help you identify viable candidates? Have your nearest public workforce center, now called KansasWorks, help you find candidates through free services, including revision of job descriptions and ads, scheduling job fairs and providing screening tests and assessments so you get prospects that meet your predefined qualifications.

Secondly, interview prospects using behavior-based questions. Ask "What if..." and "Tell us about a time when ..." questions. Past performance is a good predictor of future behavior. More truth comes out about a person's work ethics in interviews based on behavioral questions than any other interview method.

What about a good orientation

and a mentor? Training is such an important component of the successful employee's work life. Provide the understanding necessary to complete the tasks you have detailed in the job description. Send your employees to seminars or workshops. Allow them to enroll in a class that helps hone their skills. Match them with a seasoned worker who can coach them and answer questions, providing a good example of how the work is done in your company.

During quarterly reviews, ask them what information they need to learn and in what areas they would like to increase proficiency. A growing employee is an engaged employee. This performance evaluation is also a good time to discuss ideas employees have to perform more efficiently, opening the door to their ideas and showing them they are valued as a team member.

Finding and keeping good employees is hard work, but it's vital to bottom-line success and reduction in your stress. Turnover is estimated at 1.5 times the annual salary of your employee. The time and effort put into the search, interview, orientation and mentoring process will reap bountiful rewards in employee retention and satisfaction.
