applicants this fall. He said all 26 scholars that were accepted had an ACT score of 25 or higher. One of this year's scholars lives in Colby, he added.

- Heard that the school must continue to focus on trying to enroll students from outside the 14 counties in northwest Kansas, where high school enrollment has been shrinking.
- "Enrollment will not increase in our counties because the populations continue to dwindle," Kreider said. "If we keep only looking in the (14) county area, we will continue to go downhill. We need to recruit in Nebraska, Colorado, China and Korea."
- But Kreider added the school is still recruiting in the 14 counties.
- Public Information Director Debbie Schwanke said \$7,963,000 of the college's 2008-2009 school budget has been spent. She said the school started out with a budget of about \$11 million.
- The college has spent \$230,000 of the money allotted for the technology budget this year, said Waits.

He said the school will spend close to \$300,000 by the end of the year. The amount is based on technology fees from student enrollment, said Waits. The large amount of the budget spent at the beginning of the year relates to putting in new equipment, he said.

The school has spent \$125,000 on equipment and infrastructure, including a consolidated storage system, "smart" classrooms, faculty laptops, Internet connection, a server upgrade, cabling, supplies and on items in the Ferguson Lab, he said. It has also spent \$105,000 on AXIO, an online technology-based method of instruction. The money spent on the program was used to pay for the salaries and benefits of teachers involved in the program and to pay Kansas State University for helping administer the program.
