Next was Craig Fulwider with 46. There were five write-in votes. All numbers are subject to certification by the commissioners at Monday's meeting.
Although no one filed for mayor or city council in **Menlo**, there were 13 write-in votes for mayor and 65 for five council positions.
The city of **Gem** had 36 write-in votes for three positions on the council, with no one on the ballot. Winners will be determined as write-ins are counted.
Oakley School Board winners were Scott A. Maurath, 381 votes; Anita Gabel, 264; and Debbie Runnalls 295 to fill three seats.
In city voting, banker Jerry Robben was elected mayor with 354 votes to 62 write ins. For city council, Shawna M. Allison had 286 vote and Roger Boyd 170 for two seats. Russ Kahle had 145, Frank Munk 138, Butch Burris 111 and Anna Pentico 45.
Biggest vote tallies for two seats on the **Rexford City Council** were Betty J. Nickols with 26 votes and Gary Delzeit, 23, followed by 12 votes for Penny Vogler and one write in.

work to keep providing students with the best education possible. The board can't know where it will have to make cuts until the state Legislature finishes the bud-

get, he said. Superintendent Terrel Harrison has been meeting with department heads and principals about what they can do once the Legislature decides how steep the budget cuts will be, Rogers said. Frahm agreed the board needs

to keep striving to give students a quality education.
"We must deal with budget cuts in a way that causes the least trouble for the school district and is in the best interest of the students," she said.
