# Junior varsity volleyball team wins first two games of season

The Colby junior varsity volleyball team crushed Osborne in two sets (25-11, 25-15) in the first match of a triangular between the two schools and Norton on Tuesday at the high school. The Lady Eagles grabbed a quick 8-2 lead early in the first set, then freshman Alexa Haas scored on consecutive serves to make it 10-2 Colby. Later, with the Lady Eagles

leading 20-8, junior Anna Taylor served an ace to put the girls ahead by 13. The team went on to win the set 25-11. Colby jumped out to a 9-4 lead in the second set. Sophomore Haley Stickel scored on a spike to stretch girls' lead to 10-4. Moments later, with the Lady Eagles now leading 11-4, Haas slammed a spike to increase her teams' lead to 12-4. A little later in the set, junior Tera Raymond scored on two consecutive serves to stretch the girl's lead to 15-5. The Lady Eagles

maintained their lead throughout the set. They led 24-15 when Stickel scored on bump from the outside hitter's position to give Colby its first win of the season. The Lady Eagles had to rally to win their next match that evening, defeating Norton (17-25, 25-22, 15-11) to start the season 2-0.

# Lady Trojans squad hammers Garden State

The Colby Community College volleyball team hammered Garden City in three straight sets (25-18, 25-15, 25-15) on Wednesday in their first home game of the season. The Lady Trojans trailed Garden City 6-9 when freshmen Gabrielly Cardoso slammed a spike to cut the Lady Broncbusters' lead to two. A little later in the set, sophomore Juliana Motta Da Silva scored on a tip shot at the net to tie the game at 10. Colby was able to inch ahead of Garden State and led 18-16 when sophomore Lisa Faimon served an ace to increase her team's lead to three. The Lady

Trojans continued to expand the lead on their way to winning the set. Colby jumped out to an 11-5 lead to start the second set. Moments later, Cardoso extended it to 13-5 with a kill. The Lady Trojans eventually built a 23-13 advantage. Motta Da Silva finished the Lady Broncbusters off with two kills to end the set. The Lady Trojans took an early 3-1 lead in third set. A little later, sophomore, Cassie Smatana scored on a kill to give Colby a 6-2 lead. The lead eventually increased to 13-7 when Motta Da Silva scored two straight points off of spikes. The Lady Trojans continued to dominate, extending their lead to 21-11 after a spike by sophomore

Jessica Merino. The Lady Broncbusters were unable to mount a comeback and Colby cruised to victory, winning the set and the match. "We did a better job on defense than we had in the last couple of games," said Motta Da Silva. With the win, the team improved to 2-5. The Lady Trojans will be hosts for the annual Colby Classic this Friday and Saturday. Matches on Friday will take place at the Community Building and Brewster High School. On Saturday, play will shift to Colby High School and the Community Building. The Lady Trojans play at 2:15 p.m., 4:45 p.m., and 6 p.m. on Friday, and at 9 a.m., 1:45 p.m. and 3 p.m. on Saturday, all in the Community Building.

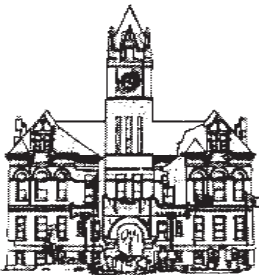
