WASHINGTON — Farm Service Agency Administrator Jonathan Coppess says that 2009 county committee elections will begin today, with the U.S. Department of Agriculture mailing ballots to eligible voters.
The deadline to return the ballots to your county office or mail them is Monday, Dec. 7.
"It is imperative that all eligible farmers and ranchers get involved and vote in this year's county committee elections," said Coppess. "County committee members will provide input and make important decisions on, among other things, the local administration of new disaster and conservation programs under the 2008 Farm Bill. I particularly encourage minority and women producers to get involved so that county committees fairly represent the producers...."
