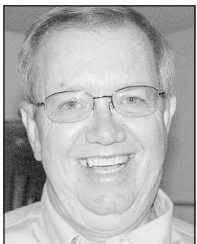

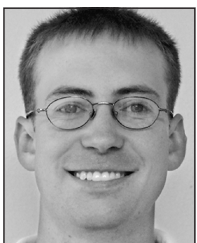

The Colby Community College women's basketball team will play again at 7 p.m. tonight against Colorado Northwestern Community College of Rangely at the Community Building.

The women are 1-2 this season, but hope the momentum from their win Thursday will carry over into this weekend.

The Trojans men's and women's teams will both be playing on Saturday in Ambassador Classic games at the Community Build-

ing. The women will take on No. 20 Independence Community College at 5 p.m. and the men will face the Sterling College junior varsity squad at 7 p.m.

The men remains unbeaten after three games under first-year coach Dustin Pfeifer. The Trojans have rallied from double-digit deficits to win two of their three games. Sophomore Aireus Stephenson has gone three games without committing a turnover.

Colby College women's team overcomes adversity, picks up win

The Lady Trojans basketball team defeated the Clarendon College Bulldogs of Texas 90-81 on Thursday night at the Community Building in an Ambassador Basketball Classic game.

The women had to overcome some adversity to pick up the victory. Sophomore Danisha Cole fell to the floor holding her leg in a pain after getting a cramp while attempting a layup with 10:49 left in the game and Colby leading 69-56. She had to be helped to the locker room by her teammates.

Cole had been having a solid game. Fortunately for the Lady Trojans, she would return to action near the end of the game to help her team secure a victory.

Colby's leading scorer, Hannah Thornton, had foul problems in the second half and fouled out

with 4:06 left.

Thornton scored a point down low by the basket to give her team a 32-25 lead late in the first half. The Lady Bulldogs closed the gap, cutting the lead to 33-32. Cole stymied Clarendon's run by drilling a three-pointer from the right baseline to make it 36-32 Colby. Moments later, she stole an inbounds pass and took it down court for a layup to give her team a six-point lead. Freshman Destiny Stewart nailed two-three pointers on consecutive possessions to give her team a 44-34 lead at half time.

Cole drilled another three early in the second half and Thornton continued to get buckets inside. Freshman Alecia Palm made a mid-range jumper to extend Colby's lead to 64-47 with 12:45 remaining.

The Lady Bulldogs scored the next six points of the game to cut the Lady Trojans' lead to 11.

Cole got another steal and passed the ball up court to Stewart, who drove to the hoop for a layup. Moments later, Cole got hurt.

The Lady Bulldogs' Alex Ray made a three to cut Colby's lead to 71-63 with 6:45 left.

Wagoner was able to break Clarendon's full-court press and dish the ball to Thornton, who was fouled while attempting a layup. She hit one of two free throws to make it 72-63.

Clarendon had been able to create a few turnovers with their press before Wagoner managed to maneuver her way through it.

Clarendon clawed its way back into the game. The Lady Bulldogs Donisha Bronnon got a rebound

and stuck it back in to make it 74-71. Wagoner hit Thornton with a pass right by the basket that she laid in to give Colby a 76-71 lead. Thornton fouled out, but then Cole returned to the game.

Cole picked off a pass and took it down the court, where she was fouled while attempting a layup. She made both her free throws to increase Colby's lead to 82-74. Later, Cole stole the ball and took it down court for another layup.

Thornton led the team in scoring with 28 points and eight rebounds. Cole posted a double-double, scoring 25 points and dishing out 10 assists.

Stewart added 12 and Wagoner chipped in 9, also pulling down 14 rebounds.

Trojans wrestler honored at tournament

Colby Community College sophomore wrestlers Ganbaya Sanjaa and Bekzod Abdurakhmonov took first in their weight classes Sunday at the Dan Harris Wildcat Open at Baker University in Baldwin City.

Sanjaa went 4-0 in the 157-pound class and Abdurakhmonov was 3-0 at 165 pounds. Abdurakhmonov pinned all of his opponents and Sanjaa won one of his matches by fall.

"They are great kids, very coachable and they're good students" said coach Steve Lampe. "Sanjaa does a lot of head attack-

ing on take downs, and Bekzod is a great technician with leg attacks."

Abdurakhmonov was named outstanding wrestler of the tournament. He has been voted outstanding wrestler in both opens the Trojans have wrestled in this season.

Lampe said the thing that's unusual about the two is they both like to wrestle from "down" positions. Most international athletes prefer to start matches on their feet, he said, because in other countries, a wrestler never begins a match on the mat.

The meet featured 14 colleges

and more than 160 wrestlers.

Freshman Luis Camacho snared third overall at 133. Camacho won four straight matches after losing his first match of the day.

"He did a great job," said Lampe.

Freshman Brent Luedke, a Colby native, finished 4-2 at 133, taking fifth place.

"He's a good all-around wres-

tlar," said Lampe. "He has a lot of grit."

Freshman Jonathan Hill went 0-2 in the 174 pound class and Pat Fletcher went 0-2 at 149. Freshman Eli Jackson went 1 and 2 in the 197 pound class and freshman Everett Urban went 2-2 at 149 pounds. Freshman Cody Wark went 1-2 in the 125 pound class.
