

Colby College women's team overcomes adversity, picks up win

The Lady Trojans basketball with 4:06 left. team defeated the Clarendon College Bulldogs of Texas 90-81 on Thursday night at the Community Building in an Ambassador Basketball Classic game.

The women had to overcome some adversity to pick up the victory. Sophomore Danisha Cole fell to the floor holding her leg in a pain after getting a cramp while attempting a layup with 10:49 left in the game and Colby leading 69-56. She had to be helped to the locker room by her teammates.

Cole had been having a solid game. Fortunately for the Lady Trojans, she would return to action near the end of the game to help her team secure a victory.

Colby's leading scorer, Hannah Thornton, had foul problems in the second half and fouled out

Thornton scored a point down low by the basket to give her team a 32-25 lead late in the first half. The Lady Bulldogs closed the gap, cutting the lead to 33-32. Cole stymied Clarendon's run by drilling a three-pointer from the right baseline to make it 36-32 Colby. Moments later, she stole an inbounds pass and took it down court for a layup to give her team a six-point lead. Freshman Destiny Stewart nailed two-three pointers on consecutive possessions to give her

team a 44-34 lead at half time. Cole drilled another three early in the second half and Thornton continued to get buckets inside. Freshman Alecia Palm made a mid-range jumper to extend Colby's lead to 64-47 with 12:45 re-

Cole got another steal and passed the ball up court to Stewart, who drove to the hoop for a layup. Moments later, Cole got hurt.

The Lady Bulldogs' Alex Ray made a three to cut Colby's lead to 71-63 with 6:45 left.

Wagoner was able to break Clarendon's full-court press and dish the ball to Thornton, who was fouled while attempting a layup. She hit one of two free throws to make it 72-63.

Clarendon had been able to create a few turnovers with their press before Wagoner managed to maneuver her way through it.

Thornton led the team in scoring with 28 points and eight rebounds. Cole posted a double-double, scoring 25 points and dishing out 10 assists.

Stewart added 12 and Wagoner chipped in 9, also pulling down down 14 rebounds.
