Each new customer and each customer moving from one residence or business to another within the City shall make a separate deposit for water service and electric service in an amount estimated to equal the maximum bill to be rendered by the City for two months' service; provided, that the minimum deposit to secure electric accounts shall be not less than \$100.00 for residential customers and \$200.00 for commercial customers and to secure water accounts shall be not less than \$75.00; provided, that if any existing security deposit is not equal to the maximum service being taken by any such customer, the City may require an additional deposit, and service of such customer may be discontinued until such additional deposit is made. It is further provided that the above provisions requiring a deposit for water service and electric service may be waived for an owner of a residence who is a current customer of City of Colby utility services and who has not been delinquent in payment of any charge during the last two years and for an owner of a residence who is a new customer of City of Colby utility services with a letter of good credit from a utility company. The aforesaid security deposits may be applied upon the payment of accrued unpaid bills or bills due upon the discontinuance of service. In the case of an application of any such deposit to the payment of unpaid bills, service shall not be resumed to the customer until the amount of the deposit has been replenished as provided in this section.

Section 4. The deposit hereinbefore provided shall be kept by the City Clerk in a separate account and deposited in a fund designated as the "Meter Deposit Fund." Interest shall be payable to the customer at the rate determined by the State Corporation Commission yearly. At the second annual interest payment date following the deposit required above, the City Clerk may refund the deposit of any depositor who is the owner of the residential premises wherein such utility service is being furnished and has not been delinquent in payment of any charge during the last two years. New deposits will be required should late payment occur after refund of deposit is made. Upon discontinuance of the service, the City shall return the deposit, with interest accrued, less any amount then due the City for services rendered; provided, that interest shall be payable on any deposit for a full calendar year and interest due the depositor may be credited on any bill due the City. Interest shall not be payable on any accrued interest nor upon any deposit after the service has been discontinued. The City may invest the proceeds for customer's security deposits as authorized by K.S.A.

1978 supp., 12-1675, and amendments thereto in the manner prescribed therein or bonds of any county wherein a city of the second class is located within the state, or bonds issued or guaranteed by the United States Government or in savings accounts of commercial banks or trust companies.

Section 5. Any amount of security deposit, and the accrued interest thereon remaining in the account of any customer of a municipally-owned utility who has discontinued service with such utility shall be placed in the operating fund of such utility, upon the following conditions:

- (1) Such money has remained on deposit with the municipal utility for a period of more than two (2) years from the date service was discontinued;
- (2) No demand for such money has been made at any time during the two-year period;
- (3) The whereabouts of the person to whose account the money is credited is unknown and a reasonable effort has been made to determine the same; and
- (4) Following the expiration of the two-year period, the utility has published, once each week for two (2) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in the county in which the utility is located, a notice listing any person whose deposit remains on account and that a demand for such money must be made within sixty (60) days. Sixty (60) days after the last publication of such notice, any security deposits remaining in the account of any such customer shall be placed in the operating fund of such utility.

Section 6. Ordinance No. 1246 dated August 6, 1996 and Ordinance No. 1280 dated August 4, 1998 of the City of Colby, Kansas are hereby repealed.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication as provided by law in the official City paper.

ORDINANCE NO. 1465

AN ORDINANCE REVISING WATER RATES, TAP FEES, SERVICE CHARGES AND MINIMUM BILLINGS WITHIN THE CITY OF COLBY; ESTABLISHING WATER SERVICE FEES OUTSIDE THE CITY LIMITS; REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1204 DATED MARCH 1, 1994 AND ORDINANCE NO. 1279 DATED AUGUST 4, 1998.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLBY, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. Rates to be charged each billing month of approximately thirty (30) days each for water sold by the City of Colby to customers and users of the same are hereby fixed and determined upon the basis of metered amounts of such service and shall be billed and paid at the rates hereby established.

SECTION 2. RESIDENTIAL WATER SERVICE RATES. The following schedule of rates shall be paid by all residential customers for water furnished by the City of Colby, Kansas:

- (A) Residential Customers with 1" or Smaller Service:
- (1) Minimum billing, first 3,000 gallons - \$20.00
 - (2) All additional gallons at \$1.05 per M gallon
- (B) Residential Customers with 1 1/2" Service:
- (1) Minimum billing, first 3,000 gallons - \$50.00
 - (2) All additional gallons at \$1.05 per M gallon

- (C) Residential Customers with 2" Service:
- (1) Minimum billing, first 3,000 gallons - \$78.00
 - (2) All additional gallons at \$1.05 per M gallon

SECTION 3. COMMERCIAL WATER SERVICE RATES. The following schedule of rates shall be paid by all commercial customers for water furnished by the City of Colby, Kansas:

- (A) Commercial Customers with 1" or Smaller Service:
- (1) Minimum billing, first 3,000 gallons - \$25.00
 - (2) All additional gallons at \$0.95 per M gallon
- (B) Commercial Customers with 1 1/2" Service:
- (1) Minimum billing, first 3,000 gallons - \$60.00

- (2) All additional gallons at \$0.95 per M gallon
- (C) Commercial Customers with 2" Service:

- (1) Minimum billing, first 3,000 gallons - \$94.00
- (2) All additional gallons at \$0.95 per M gallon

- (D) Commercial Customers with 3" Service:
- (1) Minimum billing, first 3,000 gallons - \$200.00
 - (2) All additional gallons at \$0.95 per M gallon

- (E) Commercial Customers with 4" Service:
- (1) Minimum billing, first 3,000 gallons - \$336.00
 - (2) All additional gallons at \$0.95 per M gallon

SECTION 4. NEW WATER SERVICE. The applicant for a new water service shall pay the following fees for each particular service. The fee shall include the tapping of the main, service installation (not to exceed 100 feet), shut off, meter box and meter; additional fees for boring street or drive to provide service shall be additional based on actual costs.

- (A) 3/4 inch meter - \$425.00

- (B) 1 inch meter - \$600.00

- (C) 2 inch meter - \$1,775.00

- (D) All services and meters over 2 inch shall be actual cost, but not less than \$2,000.00.

- (E) In addition to the above schedule of fees for tapping the main, service and meter installation, the applicant for a new water service shall pay \$0.03 per square foot of property up to 6 acres (261,360 sq. ft.) to defray the cost of water main installation. For property in excess of 6 acres, the City will figure the cost to the developer of extending the water main and will set the fee based upon the actual cost of construction; however, the minimum fee shall be the fee for six acres.

- (F) The minimum fee based upon square feet of property shall be \$187.50.

- (G) If the water main and complete service installation are constructed under an assessment district, the property within that district will not be subject to the fees under Section 4, (A) through (E).

- (H) All water main installation and all service materials installed shall be owned by and maintained by the City of Colby. This shall include the meter

and meter box but not the service from the meter location to customer's building.

- (I) The City may require an amount equal to the estimated cost for the main or service installation and shall be paid by the customer or developer before the main or service work is started.

SECTION 5. NEW WATER SERVICE ALONG SOUTH HIGHWAY K-25. The fee provisions under Section 4, shall not apply to applicants for new water service who desire to connect to the water line running parallel to Kansas State Highway 25, from the north section line to the south section line of Section Seven (7), Township Eight (8) South, Range Thirty-three West (R33W) of the Sixth Principal Meridian (6th P.M.)

Applicants for new service shall pay the following connection and tap for each particular size service. The fee shall include the tapping of the main, service installation (not to exceed 100 feet), shut off, meter box and meter.

- (A) 3/4 inch meter or tap - \$1,000.00
(B) 1 inch meter or tap - \$1,500.00
(C) 1 1/2 inch meter or tap - \$2,000.00
(D) Over 1 1/2 inch meter or tap - \$2,500.00 the actual cost of the tap, but not less than \$2,500.00

SECTION 6. WATER SERVICE OUTSIDE CITY LIMITS. Applications for water service outside of the City limits of the City of Colby, may be granted by approval of the City Council. Fees charged for any water service granted outside the City limits of the City of Colby shall be twice the rate listed under Section 2, Section 3, and Section 4.

Provided further, that the City may at any time refuse services outside the City limits.

SECTION 7. REPEALER. Ordinance No. 1204, passed March 1, 1994, and Ordinance No. 1279, passed August 4, 1998, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 8. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official City newspaper. The water rates shall be in effect on utility bills dated January 1, 2010.
