Leaders will also have a couple of "sag wagons" on call in case there is a breakdown that is unfixable en route. They will provide sport drink mix, energy bars, and fruit at the start and at the destinations.

Runners and walkers alike are invited to the Marvin Stark 5K run/walk beginning at 8 a.m. at the community building on Saturday morning. Prizes will be given to the top men and women finishers and everyone who pre-registered will receive a race T-shirt.

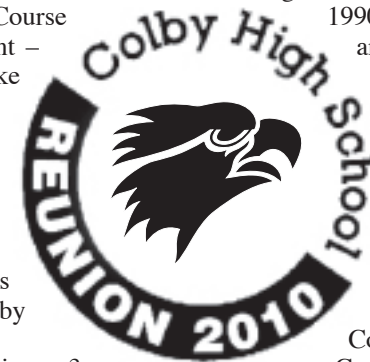
