Subpoenaed reporter gets good news

DODGE CITY (AP) — The Kansas Supreme Court on Tuesday agreed to keep a western Kansas newspaper reporter out of jail, issuing a temporary stay for an order requiring her to testify about a confidential source.
Dodge City Globe reporter Claire O'Brien was summoned to appear before an inquisition in Ford County on Wednesday. Prosecutors are trying to force her to reveal the name of a confidential source and information from her unpublished notes.
But the state Supreme Court granted the newspaper's request for a temporary emergency stay of enforcement of the inquisition subpoena. The court's order said parties in the case have until 5 p.m. Monday to respond.
Ford County Attorney Terry Malone subpoenaed O'Brien to testify about her interview with Samuel Bonilla, who is charged with second-degree murder in the Labor Day shooting death of Steven Holt and the alleged attempted murder of

Tanner Brunson. Bonilla claims he acted in self-defense.
The newspaper has challenged the subpoena on the grounds that forcing O'Brien to testify would violate her First Amendment rights and hurt her ability to gather news.
She also has said she told Malone what Bonilla said to her during the jailhouse interview when she called the prosecutor for comment.
Malone is seeking the identity of confidential sources who reportedly told O'Brien for her article that one of the victims had "a base of support that is well-known for its anti-Hispanic beliefs" and has a supply of semiautomatic weapons.
"We will respond as directed by the court and see where we go," Malone told the Associated Press.
O'Brien told the AP on Tuesday she was "heartened" by the high court's decision.

miles from the epicenter.
"Considering how close we were, we were very lucky," Streck said.
Many others were not so lucky.
"It was crazy," she said. "You could hear screaming from people in Port-au-Prince."
Travel out of Haiti was congested following the earthquake, she said. The mission team walked five miles on Thursday to the airport, where one group was able to get a flight out. The others stayed behind and eventually went to the U.S. embassy before flying to Miami on Friday afternoon, where they were all able to make calls home.
"What a relief," said Joan Streck, Naomi's mom. "We are so thankful. We want to thank everyone for their prayers and support after she received."
Streck said the mission team was unaware of how much destruction there was, or how much attention had fallen on Haiti, because the orphanage not being damaged.
"We were spared all of that," she said.
Food and water remains a concern for the orphanage, which

houses 95 children. Streck said the team left all of their food there, which would allow more time for supplies to be delivered. The orphanage is the water source for Croix-des-Bouquets, she said, but they had not turned the water on when she left due to concerns about the amount of diesel fuel they would have to power a generator.
Streck said power is limited by the city.
Streck said she is entering her last semester in college, where she is majoring in elementary education. She will begin student teaching this month.
"It's so much to take in, but I feel ready to start," she said.
Haiti Lifeline Ministries has set up a relief fund to help provide aid to Haiti. The orphanage is run by Daniel and Nicole Dieudonne, who will also run the relief fund. Donations should be sent to "Haiti Lifeline Ministries, Box 508, Hesston, Kan., 67062."
Streck said she looks forward to more mission trips in spite of last week's event.
"I would like to go back," she said. "It could happen anywhere, at any time. You can't live in fear."

County nearly done with hazard plan

outreach projects, making information such as maps available to the public, holding disaster-related events and educating school children.
Planning and zoning changes, such as not allowing new construction in a flood zone, can also help, she said.
New buildings can be built with hazard mitigation in mind, such as stronger construction, location away from potential hazards and inclusion of safe rooms and storm shelters. Many of these ideas are already incorporated into buildings such as the new Colby Fire Station, which has a safe room that can house the entire department, protecting fire fighters during a storm or other disaster so they can be ready to act.
Existing buildings can be refitted. One idea being incorporated into some new and existing buildings in Colby, the plan says, is hurricane straps, which keep roofs secure in high winds. Winds around here can sometimes get as high as those in a hurricane, McMahan said.
"The wind is the same," she said. "We're just dealing with wind and flying debris; they're dealing with wind and water."
Although the county had not had its own hazard mitigation planning in the past, she said, it does have an Emergency Operations Plan which deals with who

does what right before and after a disaster. McMahan said eventually the surveys done for each town will allow them to have their own hazard mitigation plans.
After the public meeting Thursday, a public comment period will be open until Feb. 4., McMahan said, then the plan will be sent to the state. Anyone who wants to read it can go to the Emergency Management office, 350 S. Range Ave., or the Pioneer Memorial Library.

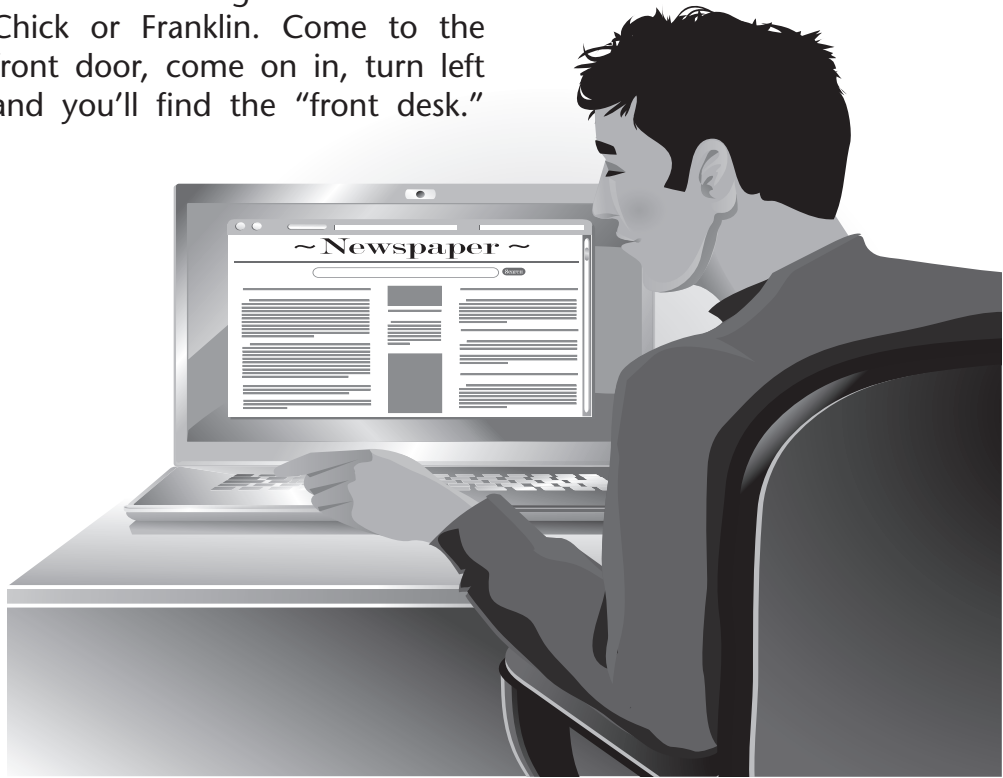
