
Weather Corner

"We had the best planes in the Air Force," he said, "and even won the Hughes Aircraft trophy in 1971. That one called for a party!"

He served in Korea, Okinawa, Vietnam and Thailand, he said. After he got out in 1962, he went right

"It was the best thing I ever did," he said. "Then I retired from the service for real in 1980.

When he got home from Vietnam in 1966, he said, he bought a brand new 1967 red Chevelle Malibu. It was the family car, but he raced it every chance he could. And because he was in the military, the car took the family all over the country.

Lovenstein said he's raced drag strips from New England to Great Bend to the Colorado Springs International Speedway.

He said it took him five years to restore the '67 Chevy he races now, and he's been driving it since 2005. He said he had a great year at the drag strips last year, and at the end of the season, with 15 cars in 1966.

in his class at the Great Bend strip, he walked away with the track championship. He said he placed in the top five every time he raced. As the points accumulated, they added up for the championship.

Lovenstein says he's looking forward to racing for free when the season starts up in March. One of the perks of the championship, he said, is a Gold Card that lets him race without paying the entry fee.

His wife Carol will be there to cheer him on. Their three children don't share quite his interest in racing, but admit to checking the standings on the Internet to see how dad is doing, point wise. Daughter Kelli Hankin lives next door in Colby, son Keith lives in Pueblo, Colo., and his twin Kevin (Eileen) lives in North Yarmouth, Maine.

There's yet another '67 Chevelle in his garage in the process of restoration. Rescued from the weeds, it was only a shell when he got it. Now it has axles and wheels, and is starting to come together.

And you can bet, it will be wearing a coat of shiny red paint just like the one he bought brand new back


