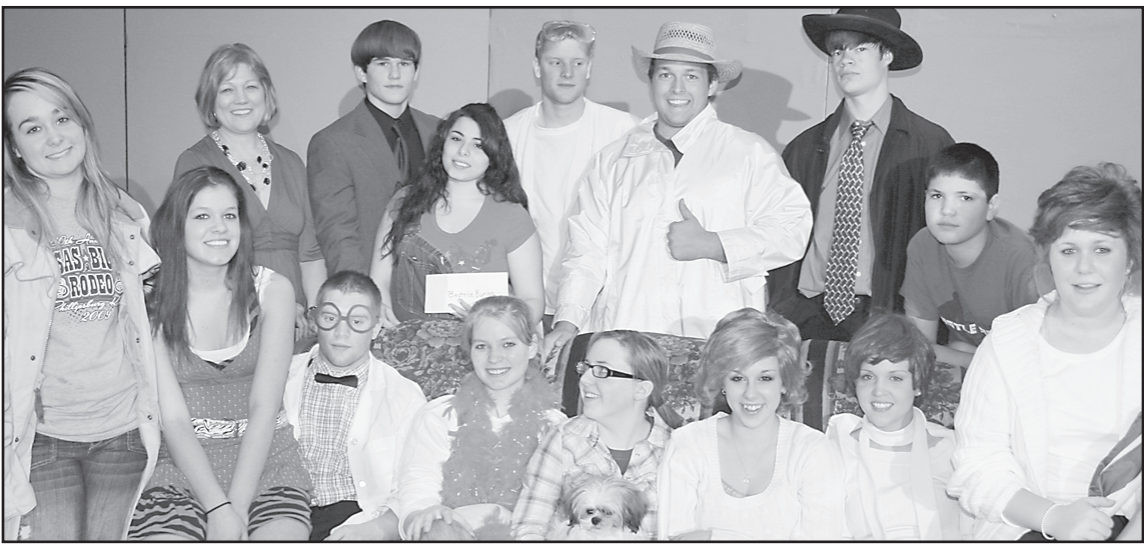
The Golden Plains High School play this year was “Foibles and Folly,” by Michelle R. Davis. The main idea of the play was not to judge people, especially when you first meet them.

## Grain sorghum meet to be held in Hill City

The Graham County Extension office will hold a free grain sorghum production meeting from 1 to 4 p.m. Tuesday, Feb. 23, at 4-H Building on the Graham County Fairgrounds in Hill City.

K-State Research and Extension specialists Kraig Rooseboom, Curt Thompson and Brian Olson will update farmers on the latest in sorghum produc-

tion, weed and insect control and fertility issues. This will be an excellent opportunity to get a jump on the new season, Rooseboom said.

A minimum of 10 participants is required to hold this event, Olson said, so make your reservation soon by calling Graham County Extension at (785) 421-3411.

## Webinar to inform farmers about program

Kansas State University will host a webinar at noon Friday, Feb. 19, on the federal Supplemental Revenue Assistance Program for farmers in Kansas and elsewhere who grow corn, sorghum, wheat, soybeans, forage and other crops.

The program is tied directly to the type and level of crop insurance purchased, said Art Barnaby, risk management specialist with K-State Research and Extension. When farmers make their coverage decision before March 15, they also are making their deci-

sion on coverage provided by the program.

In general, it is a whole-farm revenue “insurance” guarantee, Barnaby said.
