Gerstner said ways citizens and businesses could help survivors could include providing rides to doctor appointments, offering free or discounted meals and family or individual counseling and providing daily living, financial, health or rehabilitation services.

Sellers said the first steps for the project include a web page including a link to an interactive map. Survivors or caregivers who visit the site will see a map of Kansas. They can choose their location, and a list of resources will appear, including agency names, addresses, phone numbers, web addresses and a description programs that

could help survivors.

Sellers said the next level involves Extension agents, who will work with a community member, a caregiver, survivor or advocate for traumatic brain injury victims.

"This community member will provide support and assistance to the agents," said Sellers. "With that support, agents will canvass their communities and provide localized resources to the database to ensure that all locals services and supports have been identified for inclusion into the interactive map."


