


# Grease fires stop cold with soda

Dear Heloise: I read your article in the Lubbock (Texas) Avalanche-Journal about using baking soda on GREASE FIRES. Well, I was making candy, and it boiled over and started a fire.

Thanks to your article, I grabbed my baking soda and put it out. Saved my kitchen - not sure about my candy, though! - K.S. in Texas

Yikes! Making candy should be fun, not dangerous! Grease fires can be terrifying and, of course, hazardous. Keep a box of baking soda close at hand when cooking on the stove top. If there is a flare-up, first TURN OFF THE HEAT, stand back from the stove and lightly pitch a handful or two of baking soda at the BOTTOM of the flame; don't pour the baking soda on top of the fire, as this could cause the flames to spread. If the fire is in a deep-fat fryer, don't use this method - the situation might get much worse. Turn off the heat and cover the appliance with a big metal lid to smother the flames. In either case, stove top or deep fryer, if the fire gets out of control, call 911 - right away! Baking soda is a workhorse around the house and can save you money. #### **Bidding Quiz** 1. Three hearts. Responses by a player who

has previously passed are in an entirely different category from those made by a player who has not passed before. Obviously, a player who previously passed has denied the values for an opening bid. A player opening in third or fourth position is consequently not obligated to bid again if, in his opinion, there's no reasonable chance for a game opposite a passed partner.

In the given case, a two-diamond response, showing 10 or more points, therefore would not compel partner to bid again, as it would if South had not passed initially.

hearts is not forcing. Partner can pass whenever, in his judgment, he feels four hearts cannot be made. However, a jump to three hearts is much more likely to induce him to continue bidding

is preferable to two clubs or one notrump, either of which partner might pass. The heart raise has a better chance of coaxing another bid from him because the announced trump fit will automati-

cate 13 to 15 points, but after passing, the jump to two notrump shows 11 or 12 points, balanced distribution and stoppers in the unbid suits.

4. Two clubs. The practice of naming the longer suit first is followed here, as usual. You intend to bid spades next over partner's expected heart rebid. Partner is thus apprised that you have only four spades and greater length in clubs. Game is very unlikely if partner passes two clubs.

5. Four hearts. It would be unwise to risk a three-heart bid that partner might pass, since your hand is much more likely to produce 10 tricks

hand becomes worth at least 13 points. This, added to partner's expected 13 or more, gives you the requisite 26 points needed for game, but only you know the combined total. It's far better to live slightly dangerously than to run the risk of missing a cold game.


