

TOPEKA - A special Kansas House committee dismissed a misconduct complaint Tuesday by Democrats against Republican Speaker Mike O'Neal that alleged he is improperly representing special interests in a lawsuit against the state.

The vote by the panel of three Republicans and three Democrats was unanimous. The six found O'Neal, a Hutchinson attorney, complied with Kansas law and legislative rules when he filed a lawsuit against the come," he said. state over the taking of fees paid to state agencies.


