College cuts class, keeps teacher

sion scroll channel at the college, work with Title III workers (a federal grant for online course development) and do video projects, Davis said.

Davis told the board that when recommending cuts, she takes into consideration things such as enrollment numbers and other programs at the college that would be affected, seniority of faculty and whether the college can reassign

the instructors.

She said sometimes the college has to make cuts in other areas in order to pay for college programs that traditionally have high enrollment, such as dental hygiene, physical therapy assistant, veterinary technology and nursing.

Davis told the board four programs must turn in plans explaining how they are going to grow their low enrollment before the end of the school: business administrative technology, computer

support, music and agronomy. All except music had to turn in plans to the state on Friday, she added.

Vice President of Business Affairs Alan Waites said alternative plans to cut costs include working on increased enrollment and waiting to see if the college gets any more money from the state operating grant. He said the college had received \$435,000 less than usual so far this year because of state budget cuts.

Research center to hold wheat day

Since the flag leaf on the wheat plant is responsible for 75 percent of the nutrients used to create the seed, Kansas State University Research Center in Colby is having a "Save the Flag Leaf" field day from 8 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. on Friday, May 14, at the research station.

Besides information on identifying leaf and stripe rust, K-State experts will discuss wheat varieties and their resistance, management options and sprayer setup for fungicides.
