the national loan rates for the 2010 crops at these levels:

Wheat \$2.94 per bushel, corn \$1.95, (milo) \$1.95, barley \$1.95, oats \$1.39, soybeans \$5 and other oilseeds \$10.09 per hundredweight. The rates reflect increases to www.fsa.usda.gov.
