while Olivia Wetter said her robot did very well but veered off the track at the end.

In "Search and Destroy," two teams use their robots to launch balls at each other. The robots are not allowed to cross the center line.

Olivia Wetter said neither her robot nor her opponents' robot could score a hit, so the two teams decided the match with a coin toss.

The last event is a mystery event, which is only revealed on the day of the competition. This year, the students had to program their robot to make it through an obstacle course that included two doors, sand paper and bubble wrap. They had two hours to try and program their robot to get through these obstacles.

One Colby team, whose robot ran on tracks, had particular trouble with the bubble wrap. When the robot tried to roll over it, the bubble wrap would tear the tracks

right off. Koon said many teams had problems with the bubble wrap.

"The bubble wrap was the real winner," he said.

Part of the difficulty was the limited time that all the teams had to program their robots. Only a few replicas of the obstacle course were available for the students to test their programs. Wetter said they had to jump in and do some tests anytime there was an opening.

Many of the students said the mystery

event was their favorite.

Dakota Smull said she enjoyed getting to meet new people. The atmosphere was very friendly, she said. When the Colby team found out it had lost one of its programs, the Salina South team helped them reconstruct it.

"A lot of schools were simply cheering everyone on," Morgan said.

Although the academy is closing next year, Morgan said she would still like to take students to the competition.

her husband moved to Denver in 1935 and he got a job teaching, he was paid \$85 a month.

The Brownville School District was organized in 1888 in a sod house. A brick building was built in 1933. In 1951, Brownville was annexed into the Brewster district and today a memorial marks where the school once stood south of Brewster. The oldest living graduate, Lucille (Kammer) Smith, class of 1929, is 98 and lives at the Prairie Senior Living Center in Colby.

Levant's first school was a one-room building put up in 1889. It was replaced by a frame building in 1919, and a brick building

was erected in 1924.

The first recorded graduating class was in 1924. At age 96, Esther (Dawes) Wieland is Levant's oldest living graduate, from the class of 1933. She now lives at the Colby Care Center in Colby.
