erage.

Schwanke said the cuts represent a big hit to rural colleges.

"This penalizes small schools," she said.

Schwanke said a rise in enrollment in urban schools is partly attributed to layoffs during the recession. The recession had a more dramatic effect on urban areas than in western Kansas. Johnson County Community College in Overland Park, Cowley County in Winfield, Butler County in El Dorado and Kansas City Kansas Community College had some of the largest enrollment gains this year. She said Butler and Cowley's large increases were linked to the thousands of aircraft workers laid off in Wichita.

Kreider said some of the budget gap will be closed through increas-

ing revenue, but most will come from spending cuts. Waites said next year's enrollment numbers and possible further cuts would affect the college. He said a moratorium on buying equipment, except for equipment bought with grants, would save about \$360,000.

Schwanke said one thing the college is doing to adjust is starting new online-delivery of classes this August. She said the college received a \$1.9 million Title III grant through the state to pay for the online-delivery classes. These classes could help grow enrollment, Schwanke said. She said the college is also offering a new Licensed Practical Nurse to Registered Nurse program to students this August at the Trego-Lemke Memorial Hospital in WaKeeney. Ten students will be accepted into the program.

Regents raise tuition

TOPEKA (AP) — Tuition and fees at Kansas' state universities will rise again this fall.

The state Board of Regents on Thursday approved tuition and fee increases proposed by the universities. Most of the regents said the schools need the money to maintain their academic programs.

For full-time, undergraduate in-state students, the increases will range from 4.1 percent at Fort

Hays State University to 8.2 percent at the University of Kansas.

However, many students at the University of Kansas will not pay the increase because they are part of a program that freezes tuition for four years.

For full-time graduate students from Kansas, the increases will range from 3.8 percent at Fort Hays to 8.3 percent at the University of Kansas.

pests lately, because when I took over four years ago, there were six people who called for an air spray job, compared to 30 this year."

He added that he feels the situation is getting better, and people just have to stay at it.

Rhonda Fernandez from Professional Insurance Consultants answered questions for the commissioners and courthouse workers about the employee health insurance. The firm has a contract to negotiate health insurance coverage for county employees.

The only change for the employees under the contract, Fernandez said, will be that as

soon as they have met their deductible and get an explanation of benefits letter, all they have to do is fax the explanation of benefits sheet to her firm, and it will immediately reimburse the employee. The employee benefits and deductible will stay the same, she added.

Fernandez said she will have a training for county employees before the beginning of the new insurance year on Aug. 1.

The commissioners discussed joining a cemetery in Barrett Township, on Road BB in the extreme northwest part of the county with Colby Cemetery District Three. County Attorney Bruce Flipse said that all that is required to make that happen

is to draw up a resolution that will include it in the district. By law, where there is no cemetery board, the township officers serve as the governing board for the cemetery, Flipse said.

In other business, commissioners:

- Read a notice from the state that the landfill was in compliance with Department of Health and Environment requirements.

- Heard that the air conditioner compressor for the office of the Local Environmental Protection Group had died. They called CB Heating and Air Conditioning to take a look at it.

- Transferred \$10,000 from the general fund to the landfill fund to pay for closing a cell.

Leoti council member to face recall

LEOTI (AP) — A group seeking to recall the mayor and two city council members in a western Kansas town gathered enough signatures to force only one recall vote.

Leoti voters will decide Aug. 3 whether to recall city council member Carol Berning.

Former city treasurer Jeanene French says the group leading the recall effort did not have time to gather enough signatures to recall Mayor Laura Me-

dina and council member Roger Porter.

She says the group's efforts to recall Medina and Porter will depend on the outcome of the Aug. 3 election on Berning.


The Garden City Telegram reports that French has said the recall effort was prompted somewhat from unfair treatment of city employees by council members and the mayor.
