Fowler senator wins state primary

Obamacare and one who will lead the fight against the liberal policies of Pelosi and Obama. I look forward to that debate.”

Rep. Jerry Moran won the heated Republican primary for the U.S. Senate by only 5 percent of the vote, despite a 10 percent lead in the final poll. He garnered 160,713 votes to Rep. Todd Tiahrt’s 144,272. The other two Republican candidates, Tom Little and Bob Londerholm, got 10,100 and 8,165 respectively.

Moran carried an overwhelming majority of the state’s 105 counties, with Tiahrt claiming many of the higher-population counties, near Wichita and Kansas City areas.

Moran won overwhelmingly in Thomas County, capturing 1,077 votes to Tiahrt’s 320.

The congressman will face Democrat Lisa Johnston in the general election. Johnston, an assistant dean at Baker University in Baldwin City, got 31 percent, beating Robert Conroy, David Haley, Charles Schollenberger and Patrick Wiesner. In Thomas County, Johnston lost to Wiesner by one vote.

Sen. Sam Brownback carried every county in the state over rival Joan Heffington to secure the Republican nomination for governor.

In Thomas County, Brownback and running mate Jeff Colyer got 1,163 votes to Heffington’s 227.

Brownback will face Democrat Tom Holland in the general election.

Kris Kobach, a law professor from Piper, won the Republican nomination for secretary of state. He garnered 51 percent of the vote, with the remainder split between J.R. Claeys and Elizabeth Ensley. Kobach won Thomas County as well with 561 votes to Claeys 483 and Ensley’s 262.

Current secretary of State Chris Biggs won the Democratic primary over Chris Steineger. Steineger only carried the Kansas City area – he is from Wyandotte County – and Leavenworth, Miami and Linn counties, ending up with 40 percent of the vote to Biggs’ 60 percent. Biggs took Thomas County with 131 votes.

Derek Schmidt, the state Senate majority leader from Independence, won the Republican primary for attorney general. He beat Ralph De Zago by a hefty margin, 205,622 votes to 63,588. Schmidt got 901 votes in Thomas County. He will face Attorney General Steve Six, who ran unopposed in the Democratic Primary.

Incumbent Sandy Praeger won the Republican nomination for insurance commissioner over David Powell by 77,566 votes.

ment, officials told her the switch to “narrow-band” radios will be here soon. If the county decides to go with 800-megahertz equipment, she said, it would not have to keep building repeaters.

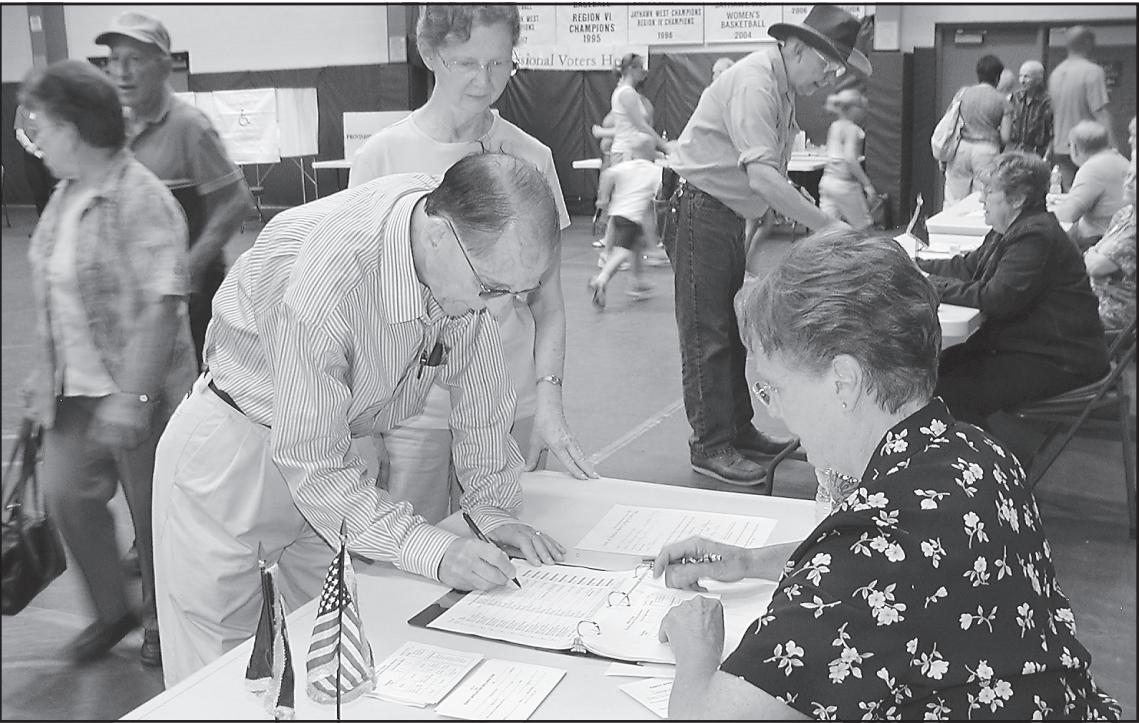
The initial cost will be a little more, she said, but they won’t know until she can compile all the figures. She said in the long run, it could be a substantial savings.

The commissioners asked McMahan to send out a memo to all county employees who use radios to hold off on any purchases. She will follow up with cost estimates before the commissioners make a decision.

In other business, commissioners:

- Paid monthly bills of \$40,833 for road and bridge, \$31,658 for noxious weed, \$132,923 for general bills and wire transfers, and \$183,337 for payroll.

- Received a budget request from the Thomas County Historical Society for \$85,000.
- Discussed a proposed agreement with juvenile services to put county money into a fund to be drawn on when the county used services. They made no decision until they can read the contract.
- Decided to meet at 1:30 p.m. Wednesday to go over the preliminary budget.
- Set the 2011 budget hearing for 11 a.m. Monday, Aug. 16.
- Decided to meet at 9 a.m. Friday at the courthouse to canvass the primary election vote.
- Heard that the county’s property-tax levy should be down nearly three-fourths of a mill. Many nearby counties show a increase, including 11.3 mills for Scott County; 20 mills in Cheyenne; 4.881 for Osborne, and as much as 27 in Stanton and 23 in Hamilton.

uncontested: Pat Tinkham got 17 votes in Barrett, Loren Guill 11 in Menlo, Travis Elias got 19 in North Randall and Gary Ostmeyer got 6 in South Randall.

Three Republican precinct committee races were contested. In Colby Ward 2, Ronda Faber beat former U.S. Sen. Sheila Frahm 110 to 77; in Colby Ward 4, Coun-

ty Clerk Shelly Harms beat Jerilee Shuman 140 to 77; and in West Morgan Township, Lisa Schroeder beat Colby School Board member Janice Frahm 49 to 38.

The results are unofficial until the county commissioners meet Friday to canvass the vote, from 9 to 11 a.m. in the meeting room at the courthouse.

To the north in the 120th District, Ward Cassidy won the Re-

publican nomination over incumbent Rep. John Faber of Brewster. Unofficial results have Cassidy, a political newcomer, winning the district by 493 votes.

Cassidy is a former principal and current school counselor living in St. Francis. Faber lives and farms in Rawlins County north of Brewster. He has been a state representative since 1997 and was influential in the House leadership.
