on any purchase of goods or services. Current proposals have the tax at 23 percent of purchases, he said, but that would be adjusted based on government receipts each year. A monthly rebate would be paid to some households based on the poverty level.

Cannon said a Fair Tax would encourage growth and especially encourage manufacturing industries to relocate back to the United States because it would eliminate corporate income taxes, making the U.S. more competitive in international markets.

Cannon said he is the only candidate in the race who is fully behind tax reform.

"My Republican opponent has said he would

support an optional Fair Tax," Cannon said. "Optional anything is sitting on the fence."

Cannon said he supports an initiative to use Kansas-grown food products in school lunches. As a principal, Cannon said, he supervised many school lunch programs.
