We regulate insurance companies and agents in our state according to laws that have been passed by the Kansas Legislature.

And we advocate for consumers when they need assistance in solving insurance problems.

One other important aspect of consumer outreach is our speakers' bureau: We try to honor as many Kansas speaker requests for department personnel as we can. During the

past 18 months we have spoken in nearly half of Kansas' 105 counties.

Consumer advocacy involves department assistance when a consumer needs help in solving an insurance problem with a company. Since 2003, we have recovered more than \$91 million over and above what companies offered in settlements for disputes.

One final area that bridges both the consumer education and advocacy functions is our antifraud effort. With a four-person staff, our anti-fraud division has handled nearly 3,000 cases since its inception in 2004, and we have recovered more than \$4 million in restitution from both fraudulent consumers and fraudulent agents. Anti-fraud staff members are also very active in statewide and national consumer and law enforcement education; they are a vital part of our speakers' bureau.

This is a snapshot of our work at the insurance department. It just scratches the surface of our day-in and day-out mission. But I hope you take away a sense that our work helping insurance consumers and providing a competitive marketplace for companies and agents is always concerned with what is best for our state's citizens and our economy.


