# Foundation offers scholarships

Students in 26 Northwest Kansas counties who have taken the ACT test and have a composite score of 21 or higher and have at least a 3.5 (B+) grade average as a senior in high school are eligible to apply for one of 265 Dane G. Hansen Foundation scholarships for the 2010-2011 school year.

The foundation seeks to encourage good citizenship and academic achievement by improving educational opportunities for students in western Kansas.

Ten Leaders of Tomorrow scholarships of \$5,000 are renewable for three years.

Fifty Hansen Scholar Scholarships of \$3,000 are renewal for one year if students achieve a 3.0 (B) grade average.

One hundred Hansen student scholarships for \$2,000 are renewable for one year.

Students from 26 counties are eligible, including those from Thomas, Sherman, Decatur, Sheridan and

Logan counties.

Ninety \$2,000 non-renewable vocational education scholarships are available. Applicants for these are not required to take a qualifying test or have a B+ average. Recipients may enroll in any vocational course in Kansas as long as it is not leading to a four year degree.

In addition to the scholarships offered to high school seniors, the Hansen Foundation will also award fifteen community college scholarships of \$2,000 each to students who are transferring to an accredited four year Kansas college or university.
