City and golf course board 'close to agreement' on lease

between two companies. Roofmasters Roofing Inc. would do the airport terminal and the new Wastewater Treatment Plant. Roofmasters is now working on the City Hall roof. Armstrong said Roofmasters did the original installation at the treatment plant and terminal.

Murray Roofing and Construction would take the Community Building, Boy Scout cabin, the concession stand at the ballfields, the airport hangar and office, the Fike Park gazebo and the Law Enforcement Training Center.

All of these jobs would have to be done within the insurance adjuster's specifications and their allowed costs, Armstrong said.

Armstrong said the library board is handling repairs to the library's roof, but the Embark building will also need repairs since it is leaking. She said she got a proposal from Murray to replace the Embark roof at a cost of \$19,766.

Armstrong said she would also like to get proposals on the fire station roof from Woofter Construction, Stephens Construction and Roofmasters. The council agreed to divide the projects as she recommended.

In other business, the council:

- Approved the Northwest Kansas Regional Prevention Center's Recovery Month 5k run/walk on Saturday. The city cannot provide police to do traffic control, however, since the department has already committed its officers to the Special Olympics World's Largest Convoy and the Department of Wildlife and Parks field day, both on Saturday.

Police Chief Randy Jones said the race route, which goes from the Colby Community Building to the end of West Fifth Street and back, would not interfere with the convoy since it is only going to Fourth Street.

- Amended the purchasing policy for "nonroutine" wire transfers over \$5,000 to require three signatures.
- Voted to continue the tax agreement with Rural Fire District 3 at 1.5 mills for the next three years. This will raise about \$35,550. Armstrong said Fire Chief Bob McLemore - who was not at the meeting - felt this was enough to cover the costs of providing rural fire coverage. District 3 covers the central part of Thomas County, including parts of Barrett, Rovohl, Lacey, North Randall, Summers, Kingery, East Hale and Morgan townships.
- Voted not to donate a pool pass for the annual Sacred Heart School auction. Bieber said he didn't think the city should donate any passes for the first year of the new pool, and especially not before the regular prices are decided. Councilman Tim Hutfles agreed, saying that although the council has donated passes in previous years, the new pool is a "completely different ballgame."

Councilman Dave Voss disagreed, saying a donation would be good public relations for the city.

Armstrong said if the council had donated a pass, they would get a lot more requests.

"I don't blame them," she said. "This is going to be the fun thing to do."

- Heard a report from the group

tasked with choosing colors for the equipment at the new pool. The group included Armstrong, Councilmen Tim Hutfles, Jim Brown and Pat Mallory, and pool backers Sherrie Wiedeman, Jennifer Burr and Stacy Lee.

Brown said they chose green, blue-violet and red for the slides and blue and yellow for canopies over picnic tables, orange for the tall slide canopies and purple for the family slide canopy. He said they picked copper and bronze for the bath house so it would match the brick on the maintenance building.

Brown said the group picked bright colors so it could be seen by travelers on I-70.

"I think it's going to be fantastic," Armstrong said.

Health department says everyone needs a flu shot

ness surveillance across Kansas and more residents protecting themselves from illness.

"There has been a revolution around the culture of washing hands, covering coughs, staying home. It's just much less culturally acceptable to expose friends and co-workers to a communicable disease," he said. "It's an exciting thing, and I hope it doesn't fade away."

Flu vaccines are being distributed several weeks earlier than normal, he said, and supplies are expected to remain ample even with more Americans encouraged to get the shots.

"It's really different from last year. Hopefully, last year was

a once-in-a-lifetime year," he said, referring to the pandemic nature of last year's outbreak and poor availability of vaccine.

Eberhart-Phillips said the best indicator of how the flu season may behave in Kansas is by looking to the Southern Hemisphere, which is approaching it springtime. There, he said, the flu has still had the same H1N1 strain and there are deaths, but the intensity of the virus is down.

In New Zealand, for example, areas that didn't have high outbreaks of the flu in 2009 are seeing more cases this year, suggesting that people who got H1N1 last year are protected somewhat this year, he said.

Bird buyers can tweet for a discount

BRAINERD, Minn. (AP) - Tweeting the old-fashioned way can net you a steep discount on a feathered friend.

The Animal Humane Society says its five Minnesota shelters are housing too many birds. To encourage adoptions, the society says those who can imitate a bird call or are willing to sing or whistle a few lines of a bird-themed song will qualify to adopt a bird for just \$1.

Officials say most of the cockatiels, parakeets and finches had been properly cared for but that their owners could no longer handle them. Many of the 279 birds were voluntarily surrendered. Workers have examined the birds, tested them for disease and prepared them for adoption.

The promotion applies at the group's locations in Buffalo, Coon Rapids, Golden Valley, St. Paul and Woodbury.
